## ITINERARY

### **Day 1 September 8, Wednesday: Depart USA**

Depart Houston Intercontinental Airport via British Airways for your transatlantic flight to the Holy Land. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served aloft. (D)

### **Day 2 September 9, Thursday: Arrive in the Land of the Bible – Mediterranean Sea**

This afternoon, arrive at Ben Gurion Tel Aviv Airport. You will be met and assisted by a Peter's Way Tours tour manager/Guide. Your luggage will be transferred to a grand touring bus (portage is included at each hotel upon arrival and departure, throughout your tour) and soon, you will be checking into your hotel by the beautiful Mediterranean Sea. After dinner, you will have an evening orientation, introducing you to the historical and geographical setting of the New Testament.

Overnight at hotel by the Mediterranean Sea. (B,D)

### **Day 3 September 10, Friday: Caesarea - Mt. Carmel - Cana – Sea of Galilee**

This morning will be your first experience with an unforgettable and delightful Israeli breakfast buffet - a daily treat throughout your trip. This morning we drive along the scenic Mediterranean, stopping at Caesarea by the Sea, site of a flourishing early Christian community, where the ruins of Turkish, Crusader and Roman Civilizations are still visible. Biblically, St. Paul was imprisoned here before being sent to Rome for trial. It was here also that St. Peter baptized the first Gentiles. Visit includes the Theatre, newly excavated Palace, Hippodrome and the Harbor. Then, we continue to Mt. Carmel to visit the location of Elijah's altar where the contest with the priests of Baal is marked by a monastery. **Prayer and reflection in the garden of the Monastery.** Enjoy the breathtaking view from atop Mt. Carmel. Lunch included at a restaurant. After lunch, we visit Cana, where Jesus performed the first of His miracles. **Couples will have an opportunity to renew their wedding vows.** Then, we continue to the unforgettable Sea of Galilee for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight hotel in Tiberias. (B,L,D)

### **Day 4 September 11, Saturday: Around the Sea of Galilee – Jordan River**

After breakfast, this morning's boat ride on the Sea of Galilee will be among your favorite memories. Arrive at the ancient city of Capernaum, where Jesus started His ministry. It was here that Jesus found Matthew and called him to discipleship. Jesus worked many of His miracles in Capernaum. Here, the excellent condition of a 2nd cen-

tury synagogue undoubtedly, enclosed the sacred sanctuary in which Jesus taught and preached. Most Scripture scholars recognize the home of Peter's mother-in-law in the remains of a church near the shore as dedicated to his honor. At Tabgha, Jesus challenged his disciples to feed a crowd of 5,000 in the Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes. Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Primacy. After Mass, continue to visit the Mount of the Beatitudes, where Jesus offered His 'Sermon on the Mount.' (Lunch included delicious St. Peter's Fish).

**This afternoon, the day will climax at Kibbutz Kineret on the River Jordan, where there will be the opportunity for baptisms and renewals of vows (Mark 1:9-11).**

Dinner and overnight in Tiberias. (B,L,D)

### **Day 5 September 12, Sunday: Nazareth - Jordan Valley – Jericho - Jerusalem**

Breakfast at your hotel.

After breakfast, drive to Nazareth, the village in which Jesus grew up and lived most of his life. Arrive in time at the **Basilica of the Annunciation for the 10:00 am., sung Arabic Sunday Mass. The St. Anne's Church Choir will participate with the local Choir.** After Mass, we visit the **Grotto of the Annunciation.** Joseph's workshop and explore the magnificent Basilica of the Annunciation, Mary's Well, and the Church of the Old Synagogue, which marks the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. Independent lunch in Nazareth and time will be given for shopping. After lunch, drive along the Jordan Valley. You will marvel at the desert that is blooming with beautiful flowers, fruits, and vegetables. Arrive in Jericho, home of Joshua, Elijah's spring, Jesus' miracles and the Mt. of Temptation. Get your cameras ready for a remarkable ride along the dramatic canyon beside the original Jericho road. A highlight along the way will be our visit to the Valley of the Shadow of Death. At dusk, we will arrive in the Holy City of Jerusalem for our five-night stay.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

### **Day 6 September 13, Monday: PM/Bethlehem & Shepherd's Field – PM/Ein Karen and New City**

Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, drive to the hills of Bethlehem where you can read the Biblical account of Ruth, David and the birth of Jesus. Pass the tomb of Rachel en route to Shepherd's Field, where you will visit some of the caves, which are typical of the stables of that time. In Bethlehem, we visit the traditional birthplace of the Nativity. Here, He was born! Let us kneel down, let us bow our heads and raise our hearts full of admiration and gratitude before this sublime mystery of love! **(Celebrate Mass at the Grotto of the Nativity or at Shepherd's Field).** Time will be given for shopping in Bethlehem. **(Lunch included at a restaurant in Bethlehem).**

This afternoon, drive to Ein Karem, home of Elizabeth, Mary's kinswoman, and Zachariah. It is also the birthplace of John the Baptist. See the Church of the Visitation, one of the most artistic in the Holy Land, for quiet meditation on the meeting between two mothers... Mary and Elizabeth. Then, we proceed to visit the Israel Museum, which contains the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed in a beautiful building simulating the caves. End your day with a visit to the scale model of 1st century Jerusalem and explore Jerusalem during the Herodian period immediately prior to, and during, the life of Jesus. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,L,D)

**Day 7 September 14, Tuesday: AM/Mt. Olives & Mt. Zion - PM/Formal Concert at St. George Cathedral**

Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, drive to the Mount of Olives. The summit offers a magnificent view of the Old City. This visit reminds us of Jesus' last hours in prayer and anguish as he faced his passion and death. Visit the Chapel of the Ascension, the Shrine of Pater Noster and the **Chapel of Dominus Flevit (The Lord Wept)**. Then, follow Jesus' Palm Sunday route along Hosanna Road to the Garden of Gethsemane to visit the Grotto, the Garden and the Church of the Agony. Then, we continue to visit the Church of the Assumption (burial place of the Virgin Mary and St. Anne's). Continue to Mt. Zion, where we will pass the Tombs of Absalom and Zachariah. Visit the Church of St. Peter-in-Gallicantu. This church is built on the site of the Palace of Caiaphas, the High Priest. Here, Jesus was imprisoned and Peter denied the Lord three times. Continue to visit the Dormition Abbey, built to honor the Assumption of Our Lady. Independent lunch. Return to your hotel to freshen-up. **Early evening, you will be transferred to St. George Cathedral for rehearsal and a formal concert presented by St. Anne's Church Choir.** Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

**Day 8 September 15, Wednesday: Wilderness of Judea - Qumran and Masada**

After breakfast, drive to Bethany, where Martha, Mary and Lazarus welcomed Jesus in their home. Bethany is also the house of Simon the leper. Here, Jesus was anointed, as if for burial, by a very special woman. Then, we continue to the Judean Wilderness, where you will take a cable car ride to the ruins of Herod's palace-fortress atop Masada. Here, the Zealots chose mass suicide rather than surrender to the Romans at the time of the fall of Jerusalem. Visit the ruins of the fortifications, reservoirs for water, Herodian palaces, synagogue, Roman temples and baths. (Lunch included at a restaurant.) After lunch, we visit the Dead Sea, and you will have a panoramic view of Ein Gedi, where David hid from Saul's wrath and the locale of the Song of Songs. Later, visit Qumran, where the hidden library of the Essenes, the Dead Sea Scrolls (currently displayed at the Israel Museum), were found in 1947. Explore the relationship of their teachings to those of John the Baptist and Jesus. On your return to Jerusalem, we pass by the "Inn of the Good Samaritan." Return to Hotel. Freshen-up. **Farewell middle-eastern Bedouin dinner.** Overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,L,D)

**Day 9 September 16, Thursday: AM/Via Dolorosa - PM/Old City - Emmaus**

After early breakfast, drive to the Old City and enter through St. Stephen's Gate to the convent of the Sisters of Zion to see the Lithostrotos in the chapel of the Flagellation, where Jesus was tried and condemned by Pilate. Then, carry the Cross and Pray along the Station of the Cross as we retrace Jesus' last steps before His Crucifixion down the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. After Mass, we visit the Crusader Church of St. Anne and explore the Pool of Bethesda. Independent lunch. Then, we explore the City of David, which will lead us to the Western Wall of the Temple Mount where we will pray. Above the Temple foundations, we view the El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock. Visit the excavation of the Western Wall (Ophel Hill). Walking through the narrow alleyways and streets of Jerusalem seeing the Pinnacle of the Temple (Gate of Hulda - after Pentecost, it was here where the disciples preached and baptized). We will also visit the newly constructed Jewish Quarter "Cardo." This afternoon, visit the site of Emmaus where Jesus first appeared after the Resurrection. Return to your hotel; the remainder of the day will be for leisure. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

**Day 10 September 17, Friday: Return to the USA**

Early morning you will be transferred to Tel Aviv Airport for your return flight to the USA. This evening, arrive in Houston, filled to overflowing with memories that will change your life.

- US departure tax; customs user fee; security tax and all airport departure taxes.
- Meeting and assistance upon departure from Houston Intercontinental Airport.
- Eight (8) nights accommodation in twin rooms, with private facilities, in first-class hotels throughout; One (1) night on the Mediterranean Sea. Two (2) nights at a hotel on the Sea of Galilee and (5) five nights at a hotel in Jerusalem.
- Daily breakfast and dinner, including a farewell middle-eastern Bedouin dinner.
- Four lunches at local restaurants.
- All sightseeing, as per the itinerary, as well as overseas arrival and departure transfers, in a private, deluxe, air-conditioned motor coach.

A \$100.00 convenience fee will apply to all packages paid by credit card. Invoices and credit card authorization forms will be included with your welcome document. The credit card form must be completed in entirety in order for the transaction to be approved. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package rate or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the exchange rate over the US dollar in excess of 10% from print date. **AIR TRANSPORTATION:** Round-trip from Houston Intercontinental Airport via British Airways. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Airfare is subject to increases prior to date of travel. By sending your deposit together with your completed reservation form before the deposit deadline, airfare will be guaranteed against future fare increases excluding tax increases or fuel surcharges. Tax and fuel surcharge estimation is based on increases imposed by airlines is subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). (see LATE RESERVATIONS) Airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can be made at time of check-in only. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or double-bedded rooms with a cot or rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of \$595.00. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin rooms and are sometimes located away from the group in a different area of the hotel, and may be in high traffic areas, such as stairways/elevators. We honestly do not like to assess an additional charge for the single traveler and will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancelling, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

**LAND ONLY PASSENGERS:** A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (**\$1,900.00 per person, sharing a twin**) must notify Peter's Way Tours, **in writing**, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. *Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the land only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport.*

**BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:** Due to bus space, one carry-on bag and one checked bag per person are permitted. Standard airline baggage policies usually allow checked baggage up to 62 total inches and range to 50 pounds and carry-on baggage up to 45 total inches and 15 to 40 pounds; however, policies may vary from the time of printing of this brochure.
